Exam Policies:

1. College policy allows for rescheduling of a final exam without financial penalty **ONLY** if:
 - a. A student has an exam conflict with another RMC exam; or
 - b. A student has a conflict with another post-secondary educational institution schedule; or
 - c. A student is ill - with notification received by the Registrar's Office prior to the examination, followed by a doctor's confirmation; or
 - d. A student has more than 2 exams scheduled on one day.
2. Students with work-related conflicts are to arrange time off with their employers for scheduled exams;
3. Exams are not rescheduled for student flight arrangements. Travel plans must be made around your exam schedule!
4. Limited pre-approved re-scheduling of an exam for other than the above exceptions will be charged a \$25 re-scheduling fee;
5. **Requests for rescheduling exams must be submitted to the Registrar (not the instructor) at least two weeks before exam week.**
