



History

Rev. Samuel Oloyede was an alumnus of Mountain View Bible College who was serving the United Missionary Church of Nigeria as its General Secretary when he was killed in an auto accident at the same time as Dr. Kenneth Geiger, past President of the Missionary Church, and Rev. Eugene Ponchot, its Overseas Director. Rocky Mountain College grants this award in memory of Mountain View Bible College's first Nigerian student.

Purpose

This award is intended to assist individuals from non-western countries who are not able to get a similar education in their own country or geographic area, and who intend to return for ministry to their own country or to another non-western country.

Criteria

1. The scholarship is equal to the cost of tuition. Other fees, text books, living costs and other incidental expenses are the responsibility of the student.
2. The place of residence is in a country deemed "non-western", with final decision made by RMC.
3. Able to meet RMC's normal entrance requirements.
4. Substantial leadership and academic potential as verified by references who know the person.
5. Education similar to that offered by RMC is not available in the person's own country or region.
6. The prospective student applies to RMC through the normal process and requests this award.
7. The award is valid for one academic year with the student required to re-new the request every year.
8. Application due by May 15th.

Selection Process

The prospective student applies for admission to RMC through the normal process and submits an application for the Oloyede Award. Upon acceptance to RMC, the Financial Aid Committee will evaluate the application. Initial approval will be valid for one academic year. If a student wishes to continue beyond the first year, he/she should renew this application through a written request submitted to the Financial Aid Committee. Approval is dependent upon successfully handling academics and campus life in the previous academic year.
