

# Canadian/Provincial Student Loans

Students of Rocky Mountain College who demonstrate financial need are eligible to apply for Student Loan Funding. Note the important information as follows:

- Websites and phone numbers for student loan information and online applications are listed below by province and territory.
- Each province operates their own national and provincial student loan program, and as such, processes vary between provinces. It is important for students to contact and become familiar with their own provincial procedures regarding student loan processes.
- Loan applications should be submitted at LEAST 6 to 8 weeks before they plan to begin their students to allow for loan processing. Varying provinces may have different processing times so check with your provincial loan provider to be sure.
- Students enrolled in RMC **programs** may be eligible for loans (full time or part time). Students are not eligible for governments loans if you are NOT working towards a credential. In other words, students must be enrolled in a program leading to a certificate, diploma, or degree.
- Students wishing to obtain full time student loan status need to ensure they are registered in and meet the required minimum courseload requirement for their province. (*Most* provinces consider 60% of a full courseload to be eligible for full time funding)
- Rocky Mountain College considers 15 credits to be 100% of a full courseload
- Students need to be sure to report the exact name of their RMC program in all student loan correspondence
- Federal Institutional Code for Canada Student Loans: BPGS
- Note: Rocky Mountain College is NOT designated as a Private Vocational School/Institution

- Students can opt to have tuition amounts sent directly to RMC (tuition remittance), and if so, can be considered paid in full once an award letter detailing their loan amount and a remittance agreement are sent to the finance office (Kailynne Belt).
